What a Difference Vowels, Punctuation, and Articles Make!

Biblical Hebrew had none of the three.

Notation has evolved (points") to record what we think the manuscripts mean.

For example, Genesis 1:1

See the things below the letterforms? They are the points. And they make a difference.

KJV **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. (Gen. 1:1 KJV)

NRSV **Genesis 1:1 In the beginning when God created** the heavens and the earth, (Gen. 1:1 NRS)

^{BGT} **Genesis 1:1** ἐν ἀρχῆ ἐποίησεν ὁ θεὸς τὸν οὐρανὸν καὶ τὴν γῆν (Gen. 1:1 BGT)
